Ángel Guimerà. The greatest playwright of Catalan Romanticism and Realism. Famous internationally, his work is characterized by sensitivity towards the most marginalized and an absolute desire for freedom.

Caterina Roca was born in Barcelona and currently lives in a town near Montseny Natural Park. She is an artist with a gentle touch and a lover of the countryside and simple life. This worldview is reflected in her stories and drawings of animals and peaceful places.

Francesc Rovira was born in Barcelona in 1958. He has illustrated over 380 books, which have been published and translated into various languages. He has received several literary prizes, including the CCEI illustration award. He regularly holds exhibitions of published works and unpublished pieces.

Herminia Mas. Writer of poetry and narratives for adults and children. Her stories are tender and, at the same time, impactful. She has received prestigious poetry prizes, and some of her works, such as *The Young Woman* from Bukhara, are widely read and published, having reached as many as sixteen editions to date.

James Oliver Curwood. American writer of action and adventure novels and an early 20th-century conservationist. A repentant hunter, his books are characterized by a deeper knowledge of animal psychobiology than even Jack London's.

Josep-Francesc Delgado has written travel and adventure literature as well as poetry, in addition to children's stories. His saga of novels set in the Himalayas has been read by multiple generations, as well as his saga set in the Pyrenees mountains. He has been awarded remarkable prizes, such as the Ramon Muntaner, for his novel *The Wolves of the Red Moon*, a fast-paced story about wolves set during the Spanish Civil War, which appears on the IBBY Honour List.

Marta Ponce was born in Barcelona in 1987 and currently lives in Madrid. She studied illustration at the prestigious Massana School in Barcelona and developed a refined quasi-Gothic style. In addition to being an illustrator, she is also a violinist. Her drawings can be found in books from a variety of publishers, and she is also known for using her drawing skills as a muralist and craftsman.

Mercè Arànega was born in Badalona and studied graphic design and engraving techniques. Her expressive drawings enchant the youngest. She has published stories with numerous publishers and has visited many schools in Spain..

Núria Albó is a writer with a long career. Among other distinctions and awards, she was awarded the Cross of Saint George by the Catalan government. She has written poetry for adults and children, as well as stories and novels for both audiences.

Pau-Joan Hernández is a writer and literary translator. He is fluent in all the languages spoken in the Iberian Peninsula and translates from all of them. He is a university professor and has received several awards as both a writer and translator. He has appeared on the IBBY Honour Lists and in the selection of the Book Bank of Venezuela in 2016.

Pere Martí is a writer, philologist, and high school teacher. He has contributed to various media outlets and worked with multiple publishers of children's books and young adult literature. He has adapted classics such as *Lowlands* and written poetry books for children and adults.

Roger Olmos has received many international awards. He specialized in illustration at the School of Arts and Crafts in Barcelona and, after an apprenticeship as a scientific illustrator at the Dexeus Institute, decided to devote himself to illustrating children's books. He is vegan and an animal rights activist.

Santiago Rusiñol. Painter and writer of Catalan Modernism at the turn of the 19th and 20th centuries. He surprises us with plays that are strongly anti-imperialist and against violence. His theater often focuses on the desire for creative freedom.

Teresa Duran is a writer, illustrator, and translator. She is also a university professor and an expert in children's literature. She has received numerous awards. A subtle humor runs through works such as *The Witch's Broom*, a tale of perfect structure.

Teresa Martí was born in Barcelona. She studied set design at the Theater Institute of Barcelona. She began drawing for children after working in a school. Her original and entertaining drawings have appeared in many publications.

Xavier Salomó was born in Sabadell in 1976. He studied art history, illustration, and engraving. He has won several illustration awards. His books have been translated into English, German, Russian, and Turkish, among other languages.
